Edie Minelli and Richard Shafer of the 'Just Us Duo' will perform hits from the 50's, 60's, and 70's. Variety Entertainment show/dance








Remember to change your clocks on March 10th. Spring ahead by one hour!!!!!!!


" No" non-members can review or post any comments.....




Southfork" Community Weigh to Go


