

News from The HOA Emergency Preparedness Team <u>July 2020</u>

- ◆ In early June, the Team put together and distributed <u>Hurricane Season Information Packets</u> to all residents. These contained hurricane shelter maps and lots of information. We thank Jerri Kaplan of the Polk County Emergency Management Office for obtaining these materials for us. Our thanks to Joyce Middleton, Shelly Shaffer, and Jerry Sibila for doing the full distribution at LHV! If by some chance you did not receive one, contact a Team member and she / he will get one to you.
- ◆ We encourage everyone to sign up for the <u>Polk Alert System</u>. There is information about this in the packets you received.
- ◆ Spectrum Bay News 9 / Charter Communications recently donated 200 '2020 Hurricane Guides.'

 These are like the 2019 version but have been updated for 2020. The Team will be delivering these to everyone, leaving them in the 'information tubes' at each home, so be sure to check these 'tubes' regularly. This is the second year in a row that Spectrum has donated hurricane related materials to LHV. We thank Spectrum and Debra Clues, who coordinated this for Spectrum.
- Since the Team is not meeting due to the coronavirus crisis, keep an eye out for announcements that may be posted on the LHV Facebook page.
- ◆ The Team still has a number of 'Hurricane Lights' available (free of charge, of course, batteries included), donated last year by Spectrum Bay News 9. These small battery-operated lights have three settings, a magnetic bottom, and are extremely useful around the house.

Notes on Hurricane Season 2020

We are now well into the 2020 Hurricane Season, which runs until the end of November. So far, one major storm was spotted in the gulf area but never developed into a threat to our area.

However, as sure as we must pay taxes each year, we know **STORMS ARE COMING OUR WAY!** Another sure thing is that **WE WILL HAVE VERY LITTLE NOTICE!**

So, the time to plan is **NOW!**

You do not have to be Nostradamus to realize that when the storm is approaching, the following will also occur:

- There will be long lines at gas stations. You may not be able to fill your tank. Recommendation: keep it filled, just in case.
- o Walmart & other retail stores will run out of bottled water. Recommendation: Buy it now
- o You will not be able to find batteries or flashlights. Recommendation: Buy them now
- o Canned goods will disappear from the shelves too. Recommendation: Buy them now
- Local hotels and maybe hotels in the immediate area will not have rooms available.
 Recommendation: Start thinking about whether you will need to evacuate and MAKE A PLAN NOW!
- You will not have much time to prepare your home for the coming storm removing items from the yard, etc. Recommendation: Start now. See below if you need help.
- NOW IS THE TIME to think about qualifying for Polk County Special Needs Program. If you
 have medical restrictions, are on oxygen, or have other medical issues which restrict your
 activities, you may qualify. Recommendation: Contact a Team Member for help

These are only a few of the things you can expect. Some of you have been through previous storms and may have a plan. We have many new residents who have not and may need help.

The HOA's Emergency Preparedness Team was formed in 2018 to provide information and assistance to residents.

We have distributed a shelter listing and other useful information to all residents.

We have also distributed Hurricane Lights to everyone and have them available to new residents.

The Team has a Volunteer Plan to help you. This was outlined in last month's issue of Gator Tales.




