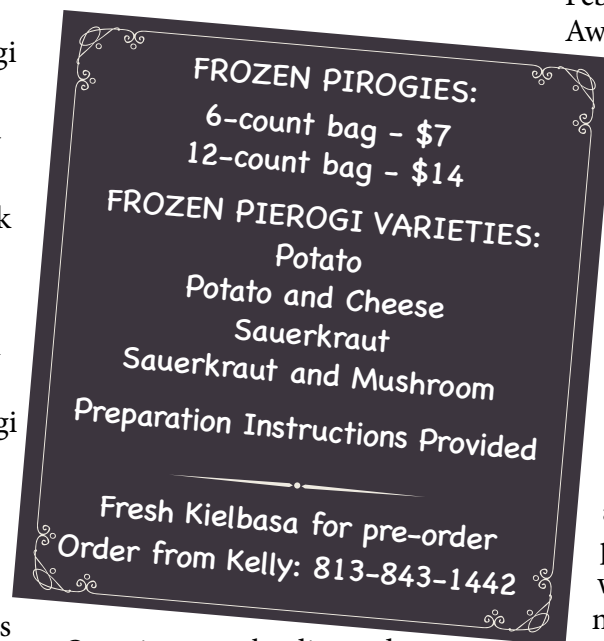
MAMA G'S PIEROGI FOOD TRUCK IS *on the road again!*
