HOA Membership is a fun way to meet your neighbors and fully participate in your community. **See you soon!**



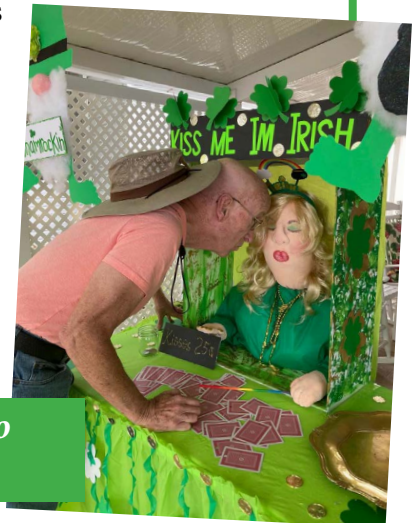
