SOUTHWESTERN CHICKEN ROLLUPS

6 6oz Chicken Breasts

6 Tbsp Cream Cheese

6 Tbsp[Picante Sauce

6 Cilantro Springs

6 Tbsp Italian Bread Crumbs

350 oven..Pound chicken to 1/4" thick. Top each with 1 Tbsp cream cheese, 1 Tbsp Picante, sauce and 1 sprig of cilantro. Dredge in bread crumbs. Place seam side down on sprayed baking sheet. Lightly spray each chicken roll. Bake 20 minutes.
