ST. AUGUSTINE NIGHTS OF LIGHTS

A minimum of 40 people are needed to be picked up here at GV. The bus holds a maximum of 54. The bus will pick up others (i.e. Orangewood) to fill the seats. Payment is due 1 month prior to departure. Cost is \$239pp/dbl. Rooms have 2 beds or you can request a king (for couples). Special requests, i.e. first floor can be arranged. Unfortunately, no wheel chairs or scooters are permitted on the bus; however can be put in bus storage area. All passengers must be able to board bus and trolley. We will stay at the Ponce Hotel in the historic district of St. Augustine. Dates available are Sunday thru Tuesday December 13 to 17, Wednesday thru Friday December 18 to 20, Sunday thru Tuesday January 5 to 7 or Wednesday thru Friday January 8 to 10. 1st day— Leave approximately 8am, arriving by noon. We will stop at the trolley station to get our trolley tickets and then will be free till hotel check in time, 3pm, Once you've checked in you're on your own for the remainder of the day. Day 2—Breakfast begins at 6:30am, then your day is free. Day 3—Breakfast begins at 6:30am. Prepare to leave approximately 8am. We return down the coast road and if we want we can stop somewhere for lunch. We need to determine date that will work best before we book the tour.
